#### Coronavirus

There are three simple actions we must all do to keep on protecting each other

- Wash hands: keep washing your hands regularly
- **Cover face:** wear a face covering in enclosed spaces
  - Make space: stay at least a metre apart

Please remember that if your child or any member of your household has Covid symptoms of

- 1. A fever (temperature or 38 or higher)
- 2. A dry persistent cough
- 3. Loss of sense of taste or smell
- 4.

You must inform school, self isolate, have a test and follow the guidelines.

If any child displays these symptoms in school we will follow guidelines and isolate them safely with a member of staff who will be wearing PPE while we call parents and wait for them to be collected. We ask that this is as soon as possible and within 30 minutes.

We continue to follow guidelines regarding safe opening, with some resources limited or removed and continued extra cleaning and handwashing.
