### Some activities you can try

#### Personal, Social and Emotional (PSE)

- Continue to Speak to a family member on the telephone or facetime - tell them what you have been learning about at home.
- Talk with your child over dinner, remember to give praise for something you have enjoyed doing together each day.

#### Physical

- Twinkl homelearning hub is free to access online-They have a daily timetable starting at 9am with a half hour workout- Join Joe Wicks, The Body Coach, for 30 minutes of child friendly, daily exercise in the comfort of your own home.
- Practise your cutting skills with child friendly scissors. Can you cut out an egg shape to decorate? Cut up pieces of coloured paper to decorate a hot air balloon shape.

#### Communication and Language (C+L)

- Enjoy an environmental sounds walk or sit outside for lunch in the garden. What can you hear... Church bells, birds singing, wind chimes, leaves rustling, dogs barking, music?
- Children love looking at photographs of themselves. Look at photos of special family times, ask your child to retell their memories from that event. You can share your memories too, they will love to listen to stories about themselves.

#### Literacy

- Draw/paint/create a rainbow to display in your window, it will brighten someone's day as they pass by your house. - Remember the big egg that Judy showed you at nursery. Talk to your family about what might have laid it and email your ideas to us.

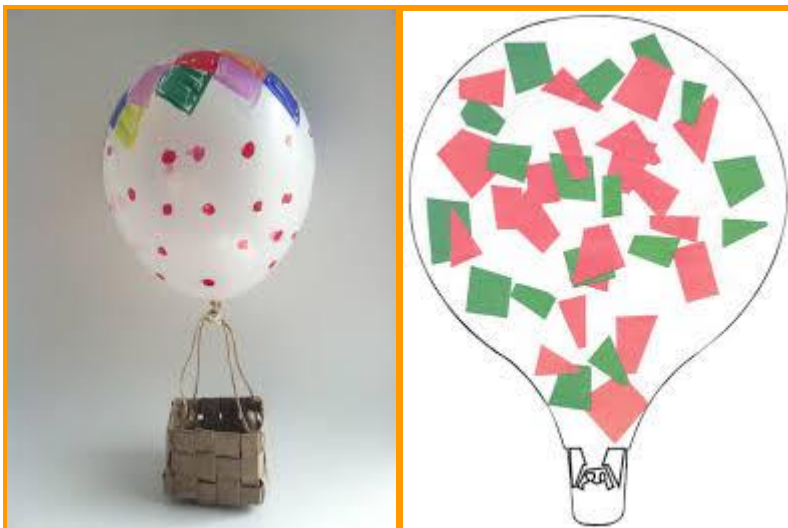


### **Expressive Arts and Design**
