

Nursery Update

Welcome back everyone. We are very pleased that the warm weather has returned and the children are enjoying lots of outdoor learning in our lovely garden.



The children are all very excited about our new water pump station. They have been busy exploring how the pumps work to transport the water along the pipes. We have also had fun exploring the properties of water, emptying and filling containers and getting rather wet in the process!



We are busy learning about numbers and counting out different amounts of natural objects. The children have had fun picking up the objects using tweezers and tongs, developing fine motor skills ready for mark making.

The children have been painters and decorators, using rollers to paint the outside house. We used blue and yellow paint and the children quickly noticed that the two colours mixed together to make green. check availability. We ask for payment in advance for these sessions.

<u>Snack Time</u>

Please could we ask you to put healthy snacks in your child's lunchbox for them to have at snack times. We usually ask parents to send in snacks to share but in order to ensure safety the children are just eating their own food for now. Your child will also need their own named drink bottle which staff are happy to top up with water during the day.

Young children can develop a nut allergy at any time, so please ensure you do NOT send in anything containing nuts into school

Lost property

Please could you ensure that all coats, welly boots, hoodies and cardigans are labelled with your child's name. A biro name or initials on the label is sufficient.

Please make sure your child's name is on water bottles, lunch boxes and any loose tupperware boxes.

School Funds

We ask parents for a **donation of £5 per term.** Thank you to those who have donated so far. The donations help towards a variety of activities which will enhance your child's learning. The best way to donate is through the Parentmail App however you are able to bring in a cash donation if you cannot access parentmail.

Clothing and Donations

We are in need of socks and jogging bottoms for both girls and boys, if you have any spares at home please bring them in. Please return any nursery clothing that your child has borrowed.

No Mobile Phones Policy

Please could we remind all parents and visitors that mobile phones must not be used while on school premises, this includes the nursery garden. This is a statutory regulation which we are legally obliged to enforce.

Sickness reminder: Please ring 111 if your child is unwell and follow their advice. If they have had common childhood illnesses such as D and V children should not come back to Nursery/School until 48 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea. 
